We are located in Lake County, Madison, Ohio very near to the Ashtabula County line. The Debevc family estate includes over 120 acres of grapes, a Pressing House, Juice House, Wine Bottle Aging Facility, and Wine Cellar with Aging Rooms, Wine Bar & Hospitality Room, Gift Shop, and Outdoor Wineglass Amphitheatre. Visitors are welcome all year.

Debonne Vineyards is one of the premier boutique wineries in the United States and the largest Estate Winery in the state of Ohio. This family owned and operated facility has been growing quality grapes since 1916.

DEPOSIT POLICIES AND REQUIREMENTS

A credit card number is necessary for all wine tasting and catering affairs. A close estimate regarding the number of guests is necessary two weeks prior to the event. Final numbers are due 48 hours in advance.

DIRECTIONS

Take I-90 to the Geneva exit which is route 534. Head south onto Rt. 534, travel to S. River Road. Make a right onto S. River Rd. Debonne is 3 miles down on the left.

TOUR & TASTE OPTIONS

Motor coach tours are preferred Tuesday thru Friday noon to 5 p.m.. On Saturdays, tours from noon- 1 p.m. are recommended.

Our guided tour includes a tour of our downstairs cellar including the barrel aging room, bottling line, and lab. If weather permits the group will also see the press house and red fermentation facility. In the fall, harvest is going on 7 days a week and offers your guests an inside look at a true estate winery.

Guided tour, 3-4 samples of wine served with cheese and crackers.

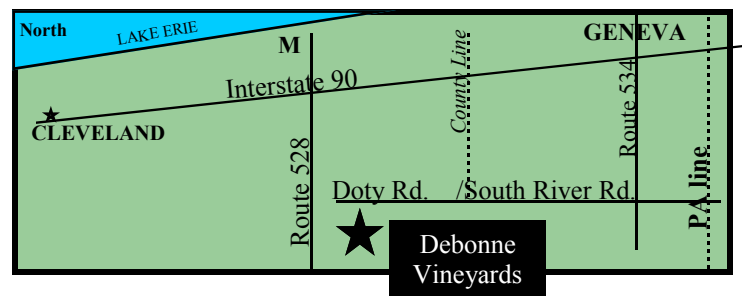

Grand River Cellars is the newest edition to the Grand River Valley Wine Region which is located in the northeastern corner of Ohio just 45 minutes from downtown Cleveland. It features a unique picturesque setting for all seasons. In the winter enjoy our cozy fireplace that is the centerpiece in the large wine and dining area. Sip wines from our vineyards amidst the Victorian charm of chestnut pews, stained glass, and a vaulted ceiling. The South River Winery is housed in a 112-year old Victorian chapel first erected in Portage County Ohio in 1892. The chapel was abandoned in the 1970s and sat vacant until it was slated for demolition in 2000. That spring we began dismantling the building nail by nail and marking all the pieces of the building in preparation for the 50-mile move to Harpersfield Township. South River Vineyard is a 32-acre vineyard estate that straddles South River Road. The farm is planted to 26 acres of premium vineyards that include Riesling, Chardonnay, Pinot Grigio, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Syrah.

Motor coach tours welcomed. \$5 pp. which includes an imprinted wine glass to take home and a select flight of wine. All tours include the surrounding vineyards (weather permitting.)

South River Vineyards is located just 45 minutes east of Cleveland and 45 minutes west of Pennsylvania in the heart of the Grand River Valley Wine Region.
